The captain stopped the ship, and we were able to watch them in very dim light for about an hour. It was an incredible experience. The picture – one of many – was taken handheld with an OM-1 Mk II and an M. Zuiko 150-400mm 400/4.5 in manual mode with center-weighted metering, at 1/500 sec, f/5 and ISO 6400.
